And with the saints and angels our humble homage bring.

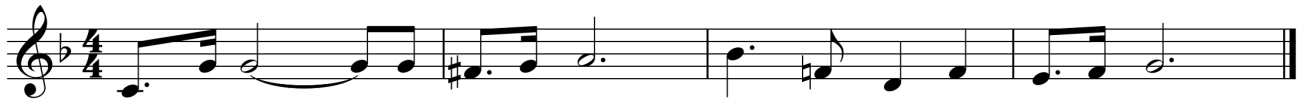
O Jesus, we adore You, come live in us we pray,

I Am The Bread Of Life

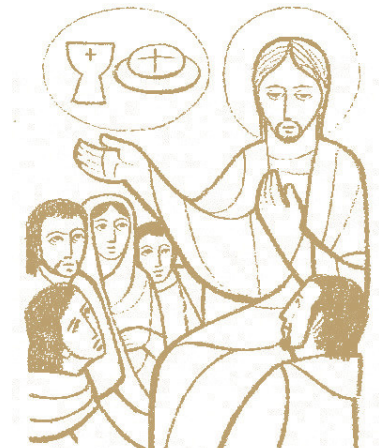
